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EXECUTIVE SYNOPSIS

DOSSIER NOTES

In preparing this background report, we undertook an examination of all readily available and relevant electronic and online records, several hundred Nexis and news articles, dozens of web pages, and several dozen public records from Nexis and the resources of various state and municipal government offices. The results of our analysis are contained below.

Typographical Note: There are a number of articles quoted in this report that contain typographical errors. These are from the original text of the article and have not been corrected when being quoted directly.

POLITICAL VULNERABILITIES AND TOP HITS

Personal

Criminal

- Sandidge has been named in no fewer than nine traffic infractions across multiple jurisdictions dating back to 2000 for myriad transgressions.
 - In 2009, Sandidge received a traffic citation in Kannapolis, North Carolina for speeding and driving with a revoked license; charges were lessened for Sandidge.
 - In 2005, Sandidge received a traffic infraction and was (technically) arrested in Concord, North Carolina for driving without carrying a license and “without having in full force and effect the financial responsibility required” of her vehicle; the charges were ultimately dropped.

Political

Civic Participation

- As a Cabarrus County, NC voter since 2008, Sandidge has failed to vote in a handful of primary elections, including the 2010, 2014, 2016, and 2018 primaries.
 - As a Rowan County, NC voter from September 2004 to April 2008, Sandidge never voted.
 - Sandidge was originally registered to vote in Cabarrus County from January 2001 to September 2004, during which time she only voted in the 2004 general election

Partisanship

- Sandidge has expressed support for prominent progressive politicians including Elizabeth Warren and Beto O’Rourke.
- On social media, Sandidge has expressed overtly partisan views unbecoming of a public official.

Policy**Covid And Healthcare**

- Sandidge appears to have fully embraced the left's punishing reaction to covid-19:
 - As a candidate for the Cabarrus School Board, Sandidge stated she does "agree with the board's decision to go to all-virtual learning" (October 2020).
 - As a candidate for the Cabarrus School Board, Sandidge stated students should only be allowed to resume in person classes "once the school board unanimously determines preservation of health can be sustained without community spread".
 - As a member of the Cabarrus County Board of Education, in August 2021, Sandidge supported mask mandates and mandatory social distancing.
 - As a member of the Cabarrus County Board of Education, Sandidge repeatedly supported keepings a mask mandate in place.
 - On social media, Sandidge promoted content critical of the Trump Administration's reaction to covid-19.
 - On social media, in March 2020, Sandidge appears to have promoted content that indicated support a "stay at home order".
- Sandidge has expressed support for Medicaid expansion.

Social Issues

- Sandidge appears to support the political left's posturing on immigration.
- Sandidge has indicated support for undermining the Second Amendment:
 - In May 2022, Sandidge promoted a tweet that called for additional gun control
 - In May 2022, Sandidge promoted a tweet from Beto O'Rourke appearing to call for additional legislation on guns; O'Rourke has previously called for gun confiscation.

Police And Race

- On social media, Sandidge promoted a video calling for the abolition of police:
 - In April 2021, Sandidge shared a tweet containing a link to a video posted on Instagram the discusses the abolition of the police.
 - Video: "What more is there left for us to say? Abolish the police. Get them out of here!"
 - Video: "You haven't done the one thing we've asked you to do. Abolish the police."

- Video: “Abolish the police. That’s it. That’s the video.”
- On social media, Sandidge has embraced radical views concerning the criminal justice system.
- On social media, Sandidge has engaged in racial politics, including expressing support for protesting the national anthem.

To date, Keshia Sandidge has received just over \$7,000 in total contributions for her 2022 campaign for North Carolina State Senate, of which over \$1,900 has come in the form of a loan from Sandidge personally. Sandidge has received \$5,150 in total itemized and unitemized receipts, \$1,500 of which has come from Mack Humphrey of Waianae, Hawaii. Individually, Sandidge has contributed \$190 in aggregate contributions to federal and state campaign committees, including Patricia Timmons-Goodson, Aimy Steele, and the Cabarrus Democratic Executive Committee.

Since 2008, Sandidge has failed to vote in a handful of primary elections, including the 2010, 2014, 2016, and 2018 primaries. From September 2004 to April 2008, Sandidge was registered to vote in Rowan County, North Carolina, during which time she never voted. Sandidge originally registered as a Democrat voter in Cabarrus County in January 2001 and until her move to Rowan County, only voted in the 2004 general election.

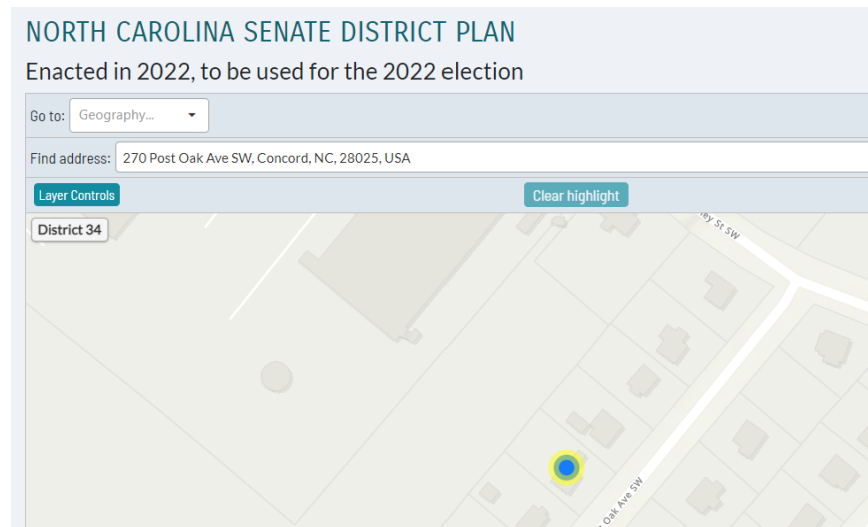
